- 1. We can't change date in Date of Request / First Contact.
- 2. This is Read Only to us.
- 3. This is the date when this consumer contacted us requesting our service.
- 4. This date is prefilled in admit page when provider adds admission in MHWIN.
- 5. This date is there in SUD Treatment Referral also.
- 1. We should be able to admit the consumer within 14 calendar days from first contact.
- 2. We need to enter reason if admit is outside of 14 days.
- 3. Your reason must be more descriptive.
- 4. You have space to enter your reason for up to 255 characters.
- 5. DWIHN can ask you more details to support the reason you provided.
- 6. If the client is the reason for the delay in admission, then we need to check this checkbox.
- 7. If it is checked, then it becomes Exception.
- 8. If not, it stays Out-of-Compliance only.
- 1. Our goal is to have none in Out-of-Compliance.
- 2. We are answerable to the State if we have many Out-of-Compliant admits.
- 3. Delayed admission can push our Performance towards Poor Performance.
