Adult Crisis Stabilization Unit

Our Adult Stabilization Services Unit (ACSU) can serve up to 12 people at one time. It offers a 72 hour length of stay for individuals struggling with mental health or substance use concerns. The ACSU serves anyone, regardless of insurance status that is 18 years or older.

The ACSU can serve individuals on a voluntary or involuntary basis, a petition or certification is not required to refer or receive services at the ACSU.



Building Empowered Supportive Transition Unit



The B.E.S.T. unit is a supportive, peer-led transitional program that helps people that need additional support to move out of care and back into daily life. Six people can be served and stay up to seven days but only with an internal referral from the ACSU.



Child and Family Crisis Unit

The Child and Family Crisis Unit (CFCU) serves youth ages 5-17, regardless of insurance status, who may be experiencing a mental health and/or substance use crisis. The unit can accommodate up to 14 individuals, with a typical length of stay of 72 hours. A parent or legal guardian is strongly encouraged to remain with the child during treatment and must, at a minimum, be present at intake to provide consent for treatment. The goal of the CFCU is to provide care to the larger family system in order to better support the family's success after discharge.
