SUBJECT: Changes to Codes for Children's Waiver Program (CWP), and the Serious Emotional Disturbance Waiver (SEDW)

SERVICE AFFECTED: Psychological testing, Neuropsychological testing, and Specialized Child care, Overnight Health & Safety services.

BACKGROUND

This bulletin is applicable to all providers of the Children's Waiver Program (CWP), and the Serious Emotional Disturbance Waiver (SEDW) program. One year ago, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) retired the codes 96101, 96102, 96118, and 96119 for all other areas of business except CWP and SEDW. MDHHS has now retired these codes for these waivers as well so that all services and codes are in alignment. MDHHS has also added a new code for Specialized Childcare, Overnight Health and Safety services, code T2027.

(i.e. no more than 12 hours in a 24 hour period). NOTE: Beneficiary must be living in a community-based setting (not in a hospital IFC/IID, nursing facility, licensed foster care/AFC, licensed specialized residential setting, correctional facility, or child caring institute).
