

Due to the reduction in businesses that can operate under the Governor's "Stay Home, Stay Safe" order issued Monday, March 23, and the expected drop in transit usage, DDOT is reducing its weekday schedule and suspending some of its "express" routes.

Service will be maintained Monday through Friday on a standard Saturday schedule. Weekend service will not change at this time. Monday through Saturday, most lines will run hourly, although major bus routes, such as Michigan Avenue, Gratiot and Grand River, will run approximately every 20-30 minutes. During the day, Woodward will run every 10 minutes.

To provide the highest level of service possible on its most heavily traveled routes, DDOT is temporarily suspending service on "express" routes, which include:

- #40 Russell
- #42 Mid-City Loop
- #46 Southfield
- · #80 Villages Direct

- #89 Southwest Direct
- #92 Rosedale Express
- #95 Ryan Express
- #96 Joy Express
