LGBT issues were discussed. Michael Squirewell spoke about the need to learn more about the LGBT community. Mr. Taylor stated that it doesn't matter whether a person is LGBT, mentally ill, etc. He said we are all human beings; everyone is Important. Ray Schuholtz stated that better training is necessary in mental health institutions to prevent abuses from occurring. Dr. Coulter indicated that she would like to have a least 2 Peers on the Authority's Behavioral Management Committee. Patty Carlson indicated that some of the employees involved in the COPE incident were fired. Blake Perry indicated that we need to bring problems in treatment to the attention of the Authority. Mr. Perry stated that he will bring Ms. Gowan's treatment at the Livonia Police Department to the attention of the Livonia City Council. It was stated that the City of Detroit has mental health training geared towards persons who deal with the public. DWMHA is reaching out to Police Departments and offering Mental Health First Aid training to officers.
