<b>Subject:</b>	<b>Mental Health Services in the Wayne County Jail</b>
<b>Provision of Service Affected:</b>	Eligible Wayne County individuals <b><u>ONLY</u></b> with a Mental and or Behavioral Health Disorder, Intellectual and or Developmental Disability (I/DD) and Substance Use Disorder (SUD)
<b>Approved codes:</b>	See attached Grid
<b>Guidance Usage:</b>	Service codes approved will be based on the members individualized need and must meet medically necessity criteria at the time the individual is receiving treatment services in the Wayne County Jail. NOTE: Only a MD or DO, or a Licensed Physician's Assistant or Nurse Practitioner under the supervision of a physician (MCL 333.17076(3), may prescribe medications.
<b>Revision Summary:</b>	The Per Diem code was changed to H2016 and the rate has increased to \$135.00 due to COVID-19.

**Background:**

Historically, Detroit Wayne Integrated Health Network (DWIHN), have utilized general funds when available to assist Wayne County in providing behavioral health services to individuals with serious mental illness, intellectual/developmental disabilities and co-occurring mental illness with substance use disorders currently residing in the Wayne County Jail. The majority of the individuals receiving services in the jail's mental health unit are either DWIHN current members or have previously received services from DWIHN in the past. Thus, this Bulletin will set-forth the criteria to report behavioral health services provided to Wayne County residents **only** when general funds are available.

## Definitions:

**Mental Health Professional (MHP) [per Mental Health Code, Section 330.1100b(15)]** - An individual who is trained and experienced in the area of mental illness or developmental disabilities and who is one of the following: a physician, psychologist, registered professional nurse licensed or otherwise authorized to engage in the practice of nursing under part 172 of the public health code (1978 PA 368, MCL 333.17201 to 333.17242), licensed master's social worker licensed or otherwise authorized to engage in the practice of social work at the master's level under part 185 of the public health code (1978 PA 368, MCL 333.18501 to 333.18518), licensed professional counselor licensed or otherwise authorized to engage in the practice of counseling under part 181 of the public health code (1978 PA 368, MCL 333.18101 to 333.18177), or a marriage and family therapist licensed or otherwise authorized to engage in the practice of marriage and family therapy under part 169 of the public health code (1978 PA 368, MCL 333.16901 to 333.16915). **NOTE:** The approved licensures for disciplines identified as a Mental Health Professional include the full, limited and temporary limited categories.

**Qualified Intellectual Disability Professional (QIDP)** - An individual who has specialized training or one year of experience in treating or working with a person who has mental illness; and is a psychologist, physician, educator with a degree in education from an accredited program, licensed or limited licensed master's or bachelor's social worker, physical therapist, occupational therapist, speech pathologist or audiologist, registered nurse, therapeutic recreation specialist, rehabilitation counselor, licensed or limited licensed professional counselor or individual with a human services degree hired and performing in the role of QMHP prior to January 1, 2008. If an individual was hired and performed the role of a QMHP prior to January 1, 2008 and later transfers to a new agency, his/her QMHP status will be grandfathered into the new agency.

**Qualified Mental Health Professional (QMHP)** - Individual with specialized training or one year experience in treating or working with a person who has mental illness; **and** is a psychologist, physician, educator with a degree in education from an accredited program, social worker, physical therapist, occupational therapist, speech-language pathologist, audiologist, registered nurse, therapeutic recreation specialist, licensed or limited-licensed professional counselor, licensed or limited licensed marriage and family therapist, or a licensed physician's assistant. An individual with a bachelor's degree in a human services field who was hired prior to January 1, 2008 and performed in the role of a QMHP prior to January 1, 2008 would also qualify. **NOTE:** If an individual was hired and performed the role of a QMHP prior to January 1, 2008 and later transfers to a new agency, his/her QMHP status will be grandfathered in to the new agency.

**Social Worker** - Individual who possesses Michigan full or limited licensure as a master's social worker or a bachelor's social worker. Social workers with limited licenses must be supervised by a fully-licensed master's social worker.

**Substance Abuse Treatment Specialist (SATS)** - An individual who has a registered MCBAP certification development plan (Development Plan – Counselor (DP-C) – approved development plan in place), is timely in its implementation, and is supervised by a Certified Clinical Supervisor – Michigan (CCS-M) or Certified Clinical Supervisor – IC & RC (CCS); or who has a registered development plan to obtain the supervisory credential (Development Plan – Supervisor (DP-S) – approved development plan in place) while completing the requirements of the plan (6000 hours).
