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PRACTITIONER RIGHTS

- If you receive an adverse credentialing decision, you have the right to appeal
- 1. The letter you receive of an adverse decision will have an appeal document attached that must be returned within 30 calendar days of the decision in order to get a review by the Appeals Committee
- 2. The applicant will receive a decision within 7 business days of the final disposition
- 3. Failure to send a valid request for appeal within 30 calendar days allotted shall constitute waiver by the practitioner of any right to appeal.
- You have the right to review information submitted to support your credentialing application
- You have the right to correct erroneous information
- You have the right to receive the status of your credentialing or recredentialing application upon request
- You have the right to be informed about the information it is allowed to shre with practitioners
- You have the right to be informed about the process for responding to requests for application status

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
