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PRACTITIONER RIGHTS

- If you receive an adverse credentialing decision, you have the right to appeal
 1. The letter you receive of an adverse decision will have an appeal document attached that must be returned within 30 calendar days of the decision in order to get a review by the Appeals Committee
 2. The applicant will receive a decision within 7 business days of the final disposition
 3. Failure to send a valid request for appeal within 30 calendar days allotted shall constitute waiver by the practitioner of any right to appeal.
- You have the right to review information submitted to support your credentialing application
- You have the right to correct erroneous information
- You have the right to receive the status of your credentialing or re-credentialing application upon request
- You have the right to be informed about the information it is allowed to share with practitioners
- You have the right to be informed about the process for responding to requests for application status

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
