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Dear DWIHN ACT Provider Network:

Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) is a therapeutic set of services bundled into one reimbursement code (H0039) and include intensive clinical, medical and psychosocial services provided by a mobile multi-disciplinary treatment team. Services also include case/care management, psychiatric services, counseling/psychotherapy, housing support, substance use disorders treatment, employment, pre-admission review screenings, peer support and rehabilitative services provided in the beneficiary's home or community. ACT provides basic services and supports essential to maintaining the beneficiary's ability to function in community settings, including assistance with accessing basic needs through available community resources (such as food, housing, medical care and supports) to allow beneficiaries to function in social, educational, and vocational settings.

DWIHN is committed to providing individuals and families served with evidence-based practices. ACT is one of the many evidence-based therapeutic interventions provided to eligible individuals in our network. Proper authorization for services ensures fiscal responsibility for our network, which in turn allows delivery of ACT services to more individuals who meet eligibility criteria. In order to ensure equitable access to eligible member's additional requests for authorizations, the only service codes that can be authorized outside of the ACT bundle (H0039) are those listed below. Please review the list of allowable services that can be authorized in conjunction with ACT (H0039) when clinically appropriate. These services will be reimbursed at the fee-for-service rate:

- H0023 - Drop In
- H2015 - Comprehensive Community Support Services
- H0043 - Community Living Supports
- H2023 - Supported Employment
- H2030 - Mental Health Clubhouse Services
- H0003 - Alcohol and/or Drug Screening; Lab Analysis (12 Panel)
- H0015 - Intensive Outpatient; level 3 (minimum 4-5 hrs/day; 5 days/week)
- H0018 - Behavioral Health; Short-Term Residential
- S9976 - Lodging; Recovery (Room & Board)
- H0020 - methadone medication (provision and administration by a licensed program)
- All hospital inpatient services
- Jail services
