(Ages 17 and under)

DWIHN partners with The Guidance Center and New Oakland Family Centers to complete timely crisis evaluations for youth in acute crisis in local emergency departments 24/7.

New Oakland Family Centers screens youth with intellectual/developmental disabilities (I/DD) in crisis. The Guidance Center screens youth with serious emotional disturbances (SED).

Upon evaluation and assessment, services offered include:

- Crisis residential
- Inpatient hospitalization
- Linkage to community mental health
- Short-term crisis intervention/stabilization

This service is available 24 /7, including weekends and holidays.
